From Rev Tom

Erin Killion is the current community organiser for the Hunter Community Alliance (HCA). Erin gave me a call last week to tell me about where they are at to address the housing crisis in the Hunter. In particular Erin spoke about the Broadmeadow housing redevelopment project. The plan is to build 20,000 new homes in that vicinity!!

The NSW Government promised that 30% of those homes would be social and affordable housing on that public land. Those who went to the HCA Assembly will have heard what sounded like a renewed commitment to that goal. Well, since then there has not been a word mentioned about social or affordable housing as part of the plan.

Now, after mentioning all this Erin got a bit deeper and my memory of what she said gets more sketchy. The Alliance Housing Research Action Team has continued researching the behind-the-scenes activity on the subject. What they discovered is that, all the funding to achieve the 30% goal is in place from both the state and federal governments.

However, and unfortunately, or maybe fortunately, I am unable to relay the detail here, but the big problem is red-tape. We often hear about red-tape in bureaucratic systems and it seems it is streaming through the whole housing issue. Well, it seems that now is the time to give our governments a prod to make good on their promises and clear a pathway to address what is described by the majority of Australians as our leading national concern.

Community organising uses many strategies to achieve the greater good. Most of the time it is a consultative process. But when that gets stuck it pulls another arrow from the quiver - public action. Politicians are very sensitive to ordinary citizens getting out there in public to voice their concerns. So, the HCA has organised a public gathering this Friday 5th December at 11am Cnr Griffiths and Chatham Rd, Hamilton North (there is a park there).

This event has already been reported in the media at it seems that just on that news one local politician has contacted the Housing Research Action Team to organise a meeting. But to make a difference we need to get communication going with both state and federal representatives. So, a large gathering on Friday will go into the news, with a reminder of promises not fulfilled.

So, this is first to simply let people know the back story. But it is also a call for whoever can get there on Friday. I believe it is going to be hot so Rob Hanks is making sure there is plenty of water, and people are advised to bring an umbrella (that makes for an even greater visual impact). There is a program that will take about 45 minutes, with some personal stories, and some experts explaining what needs to be done to achieve the agreed goal. So, it will be great if you can get there ... and a prayer for the occasion and a change in direction is just, if not more, essential!!



Our Milson St Hub is used by a number of groups, renting the varied spaces we offer. Their presence is integral to our mission to build a community where creativity, justice and spirituality are valued and available to all. In a more pragmatic view, their presence also helps maintain financial viability of our premises.

Groups using the worship space have various needs; performance, rehearsals, contemplation, and need to be able to move some of the seating. We have found the church pews to be very awkward and heavy to reposition.

The plan is to bring over the chairs from Garden Suburb to begin the transition to flexible seating. As more chairs are acquired, more pews can be replaced. To ensure comfort and mobility, there will be some with arms and some without.
